Welcome to our Cookie Policy (the "Policy"), where we explain what "Cookies" are, how they are used on our website, and how you can manage them. This Policy works alongside our Privacy Policy.

As with our Privacy Policy, this Policy is issued voluntarily, in line with the right to privacy under Article 13 of the Namibian Constitution and with recognised international cookie and e-privacy practices, pending the enactment of Namibia's Data Protection Bill.

WHAT EXACTLY ARE "COOKIES"?

Cookies are small text files that we store on your device when you visit our website. Cookies are very common and have been used on most websites for years. Cookies allow our website to recognise your device and remember if you've been to the website before, including any preferences.

WHAT DO WE USE "COOKIES" FOR?

We use Cookies for various reasons, including to:

- Enhance the performance of our website and personalise your experience on our website;
- Tailor our website's functionality to your personal preferences by allowing our website to remember your preferences, location, or device type;
- Help us improve our website and provide a better user experience;
- Help us understand how our website is being used and which pages are visited;
- Help us develop and deliver interest-based advertising, in compliance with applicable laws; and
- Allow third parties to provide services to our website.



WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES DO WE USE?

We may use different types of Cookies on our website, some of which are placed by us, while others are placed by third parties.

Essential Cookies These Cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off. These Cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.

Performance or Analytical Cookies These Cookies allow us to assess the performance of our website, including counting visits and traffic sources, so we can measure and improve performance. They help us know which pages are most and least popular and how visitors move around the website. Information collected by these Cookies is aggregated and anonymous. If you choose not to allow these Cookies, we will not know when you have visited our site, and will not be able to monitor its performance.

Functional Cookies These Cookies enable our website to remember who you are as a user and provide enhanced functionality, personalisation, and preferences. They may be set by us or by third-party providers whose services we have added to our pages. If you choose not to allow these Cookies, some or all of these services may not function properly.

Targeting Cookies These Cookies may be set through our site by our advertising partners. They may be used by those companies to build a profile of your interests and show you relevant adverts on other sites. They do not directly store personal information but are based on uniquely identifying your browser and internet device. If you do not allow these Cookies, you will experience less targeted advertising.

WHAT ARE THIRD-PARTY "COOKIES"?

We may use third-party Cookies, set by a third-party domain. These generally apply where our website incorporates images, videos, advertising, social media plugins, or other elements from third-party websites. We recommend that you familiarise yourself with the privacy and cookie policies of these third parties, where applicable, to understand the extent of their use of Cookies and other information.



CAN I DELETE OR BLOCK THE USE OF "COOKIES"?

You can manage and delete Cookies manually a quick internet search will help you do this, depending on your device and browser. See www.allaboutcookies.org for more information.

You may also disable the use of Cookies by configuring your browser to refuse all Cookies, or to indicate when a Cookie is being sent. Please note that some parts of our website may not function properly if you refuse the use of Cookies, and you may not be able to enjoy all of its features and functionality.
